Step Two: You will complete the following project:


Divide the main parts of the book chronologically (order of time) into five sections.

Make a title for each section.

Write a brief summary (a shortened version in your own words) of each section.

Create a meme—You may draw it or use technology to create the meme—to represent each section you have chosen to summarize. Make sure you have a clever statement to represent each section for each meme.

Here is an example of a meme based on a section of Touching Spirit Bear, a novel by Ben Mikaelson. (For those of you who read it, the bear should be white.)



Staple your memes together like a book. The memes should represent five major and important parts of the book in chronological order.
