





Directions: Select **ONE** of the activities below to complete. Each selection must be neat and demonstrate effort in order for you to receive credit for this assignment. Use the apps available on Office 365 to be creative with your digital Summer Reading assignment. - **MEME:** Create Three (3) Memes for the book that you have read.
- **POEM:** Write a poem about the idea, character, concept or information presented in your book.
- **TOURS:** Search the Internet for virtual tours based on the book you are reading. Log your findings in your reading log/journal. Visit the author’s official website to conduct research and write your findings. Be sure to include in your findings, how the tour connects to the book that you have read.
- **POSTER:** Design a poster with words and pictures to advertise your book. Be creative...use details...elaborate...use color!
- **COVER:** Draw/Paint a multi-colored cover for your book. It must be different from any other cover for that book. Write important “book jacket” information.
- **LIST:** Create a *Top Ten* List in which you write and illustrate events or ideas you have learned from the book.
