





Directions: Select **ONE** of the activities below to complete. Your work must be neat and demonstrate effort to receive full credit for this assignment. Be creative by using the apps available on Office 365 (accessible via the MDCPS Student Portal). Also, save your assignment in Office 365, so that you can share it with your English Language Arts teacher when the new school year begins in the Fall.

- **MEME:** Create three (3) Memes for the book that you have read.
- **POEM:** Write a poem about the idea, character, concept or information presented in your book.
- **GRAPHIC NOVEL/SCENE:** Select a chapter or scene from the novel and create a graphic interpretation of the chapter or scene using a minimum of 6-8 encapsulations (cartoon boxes) for each panel.
- **POSTER:** Design a poster with words and pictures to advertise your book. Be creative...use details...elaborate...use color!
- **COVER:** Draw/Paint a multi-colored cover for your book. It must be different from any other cover for that book. Include important "book jacket" information.
- **LIST:** Create a *Top Ten* List in which you write and illustrate events or ideas you have learned from the book.
